In accordance with the latest updates from the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) concerning the nationwide outbreak of *Salmonella* Saintpaul, Adams Produce would like to inform our customers of the most recent information and warnings.

The FDA today lifted its advisory that consumers not eat certain tomatoes from certain areas. FDA has said that U.S. consumers should enjoy any and all tomatoes on the market.

The agency continues to work to determine the cause of the *Salmonella* saintpaul foodborne illness outbreak that has sickened more than 1,200 people in 42 states, the District of Columbia and Canada. It continues to look at tomatoes, jalapeno and serrano peppers, and cilantro. The FDA said it lifted the warning because no suspect tomatoes remain in the marketplace.

We will continue to update our website as more information becomes available as to the current advisories or possible recall information for jalapeno and serrano peppers and cilantro.
